This articulation is provided to assist students who wish to transfer to Eastern New Mexico University from New Mexico Junior College. You will note that the courses are categorized as academic or vocational and are alpha within each category. Students transferring to Eastern New Mexico University must complete an application for admission and have an official copy of their transcript sent to the Admissions Office. The course work will be evaluated and a copy of the evaluation will be sent to the student.

The following pages indicate the equivalent course numbers between the two institutions and those that will be accepted as "Elective." "Elective" courses do not correspond to specific ENMU courses. They will be counted as lower division electives on a degree plan unless determined to meet other requirements by a program. Two types of elective courses can be identified. When NMJC offers courses that share a common academic discipline with ENMU, the elective will be identified by the ENMU discipline prefix followed by "LD," e.g., BIOL LD. Electives for which ENMU does not offer a comparable discipline are identified as "Elective LD."

There are notations by some areas and courses in the document. The explanation of these notations is indicated below.

¹Course meets class requirement, but not upper division requirements.

²Students may transfer a minimum of 21 and a maximum of 30 semester hours in a singular technical emphasis area to the Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Electronics Engineering Technology.

³For students transferring with an associate's degree with a vocational focus and pursuing a Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) or a Bachelor of Occupational Education (BOE), these vocational courses will be used to satisfy the requirements for the degree. Should the student change to an academic major, the vocational courses would no longer apply to that degree.

DEV-Courses are developmental in nature and do not apply to a degree.

LD-The course counts as a lower division course.

NC-No credit is given for the course.
