- 6. Utilize a uniform set of data tools to collect and track information on veterans, including demographics, retention and degree completion.
- 7. Provide comprehensive professional development for faculty and staff on issues and challenges unique to veterans.
- 8. Develop Systems that ensure sustainability of effective practices for veterans.
